



Mr Han Fook Kwang spent 10 years in the Singapore Government Administrative Service (1979 to 1988) serving in the Ministry of Communications and the Ministry of Labour. He left the government service to join The Straits Times in 1989. He was Editor of the paper from 2002 to 2012. He is currently Editor-at-Large.

Mr Han is a board member of the National University of Singapore, National Environment Agency and Building & Construction Authority. He is chairman of The Straits Times School Pocket Money Fund, which provides financial assistance to needy students.

He graduated from the University of Leeds in Mechanical Engineering in 1975 under a Colombo Plan scholarship. He also holds a Masters in Public Administration from Harvard University under a Singapore Government scholarship in 1983.

Mr Han was awarded the Public Service Medal (PBM) in August 2000 for his contributions as a Board member of the Land Transport Authority.
