Total operating expenditure of ~\$22 million in 2022*

- Close to 80% of our operating expenditure is manpower related
- We have a staff strength of over 200, of which the majority are social service practitioners (e.g. social workers) who interact directly with children, youth and families (our beneficiaries)

Our Challenges

- Adverse childhood experiences or traumatic experiences are becoming more common in childhood
- Increased stressors on families (e.g. financial difficulties, domestic conflicts) can deprive children of a healthy and safe childhood
- The mental health of children and youth is worsening
- Risks and undesirable content associated with the digital world (e.g. cyberbullying) are on the rise



Our Service Goals


- Children and youth will thrive and be resilient despite the impact of adverse childhood experiences.
- 2. Regardless of their background, all children will have equal opportunities to realise their potential.
- As they move into adulthood, youth will develop positively into responsible and healthy young adults.
- 4. Children and youth who are in contact with the legal system will be accorded due process; their needs will be met, and their voices heard.
- 5. Caregivers will be resilient and empowered to manage current and future challenges so that their children and youth are able to grow and develop in positive environments.
- 6. Children, youth and families' needs will be addressed by services and programmes that are informed by research
- Issues and gaps that are identified from our service delivery and research are advocated for meaningfully
- 3. Children and youth are given opportunities to voice their views and contribute to issues concerning their future


We perform research and advocacy work to protect and promote the well-being of children, youth and their families, as well as to enhance the usefulness of social services to children and youth.


